

Corgis Puppies & Parasites

Your Corgi is currently eating Diamond Naturals “Lamb & Rice”

This is an all life's stages dog food. This is a great feed. We feel it is very adequate for the needs of a puppy to adulthood.

We don't usually feed a puppy branded feed too often as they age. Many puppy branded feeds many contain such a high protein volume that it can cause bone, allergis, and joint growth issues as well as kidney issues along the way.

We do also recommend de-worming your Corgi baby two weeks after the arrival to his/her new home. Even though we have had them on a great deworming schedule, we do not want to over work their tiny bodies too much, as they can be overly exhausted with so many chemicals and with the adjustment of a new home at times this can cause stress on the body which pulls on the immune system causing a dispelling of worms/parasites.

If you do see or recognize parasites at any time please do not panic, call anytime and/or treat two weeks after your little one arrives. Although we know parasites can be disgusting and scary to see, they are very treatable and at times can be part of the routine growth in raising babies. We do our best as a breeder, but do like to share precautions necessary when adjusting to new homes.

Your little one may not eat much the first day or two and may have some diarrhea, please do not panic. This is all a part of adjusting to a new home and/or environment with new water, noises, smells, etc. Please let us know as he/she arrives on how things are going and how he/she is adjusting. Let us know promptly should you have any concerns at all. We love our Corgis dearly and do want to be involved in assisting in the transition when possible. Be sure your little one is adjusting well to his/her new water (spring bottled water) you can mix that in as well as he/she adjusts, and that he/she has a quiet place to de-stress away from all the new noises.
